## **THE RECYCLING CENTER ACCEPTS:**

**Button batteries** - found in watches, hearing aids, electronics & some toys.

**Lead acid batteries** - found in vehicles, boats, motorcycles, lawn mowers.

**Lithium batteries** - found in many applications, primarily in cameras.  
Check all batteries carefully before disposal; look for "Lithium" on the label.  
They resemble alkaline batteries.

**Rechargeable batteries** - found in cell phones, cordless phones, laptops, tablets, ipads, e-book readers, digital cameras, camcorders, PDAs, UPS battery back-ups, some toys, baby monitors, power tools, plus rechargeable batteries that can be used with a battery recharger.

***PLEASE NOTE: ALKALINE BATTERIES ARE NOT HAZARDOUS AND MAY BE  
THROWN OUT IN THE TRASH.***
