WARRANT

TO: Either of the Constables of the Town of South Hadley

GREETINGS:

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, you are hereby directed to notify and warn the Inhabitants of the Town of South Hadley that a SPECIAL TOWN MEETING will be held in the TOWN HALL AUDITORIUM on Tuesday, the 1st day of November, 2011, at 7:00 p.m. or as soon thereafter as the subject matter of this warrant can then and there be reached, and the Town Clerk is required to notify and warn the Town Meeting Members then and there to meet and act on the following Articles:

ARTICLE 1. To see if the Town will vote to rescind the appropriation of \$895,853.00 for the Ledges Golf Club Enterprise Fund Budget for FY 12 pursuant to Article 24 of the May 14, 2011 Annual Town Meeting and in its place vote to transfer from Free Cash the sum of \$552,526.00 and transfer from Ledges Golf Club Enterprise Fund Receipts the sum of \$343,327.00 totaling \$895,853.00, for the operation of the Ledges Golf Club for FY 12, or take any action relative thereto.

ARTICLE 2. To see if the Town will vote to transfer from available funds in the Treasury the sum of \$79,739.00, or a greater or lesser sum, for the purpose of funding the FY 2011 Retained Earnings deficit of the Ledges Golf Club Enterprise Fund, or take any other action relative thereto.

ARTICLE 3. To see if the Town will vote to transfer from available funds in the treasury the sum of \$39,982.00, or a greater or lesser sum, for the purpose of paying Meadowbrook Golf for services rendered to the Ledges Golf Course during FY11, or take any other action relative thereto. This payment is contingent upon approval by the General Court of a Special Act to allow payment of these funds. Approval to allow the Selectboard to petition the General Court to enact this special legislation was granted by Special Town Meeting on July 19, 2011.

ARTICLE 4. To see if the Town will vote to transfer from available funds in the Treasury the sum of \$8,000.00, or a greater or lesser sum, to the Liability Insurance Account for the purpose of paying increased costs in the Liability Insurance Account for FY 2012, or take any other action relative thereto.

ARTICLE 5. To see if the Town will vote to transfer from available funds in the Treasury the sum of \$29,530.00, or a greater or lesser sum, to replenish the Reserve Fund, or take any other action relative thereto.

ARTICLE 6. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate and/or transfer from available funds in the treasury, the sum of \$14,180.00, or a greater or lesser sum, for the purpose of paying increased costs in the Elections budget, or take any other action relative thereto.

November 1, 2011 STM Warrant

ARTICLE 7. To see if the Town will vote to transfer from the Cable Studio Account the sum of \$25,000.00, or a greater or lesser sum, for the purchase of remote production equipment for live broadcast from Town Hall, or take any other action relative thereto.


ARTICLE 8. To see if the Town will vote to transfer from available funds in the treasury the sum of \$3,713.78, or a greater or lesser amount, for the payment of unpaid bills from a prior fiscal year for the Department of Public Works (DPW), or take any other action relative thereto.


ARTICLE 9. To see if the Town will vote to amend its Town Bylaw Section 200 for the Annual Town Election as follows: Notwithstanding the provisions of the first sentence of Section 200, the annual election of Town Officers for the year 2012 shall be held on March 6, 2012.

ARTICLE 10. To see if the Town will vote to amend the Zoning By-laws to allow chickens in Residence A-1 Zoning Districts.


HEREOF fail not and make due return of the Warrant with your doings thereon unto the Town Clerk, on or before the time of holding said meeting.


