WARRANT

TO: Either of the Constables of the Town of South Hadley

GREETINGS:

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, you are hereby directed to notify and warn the Inhabitants of the Town of South Hadley that the SPECIAL TOWN MEETING will be held in the TOWN HALL AUDITORIUM on Wednesday November 7, 2018 at 6:00 PM or as soon thereafter as the subject matter of this warrant can then and there be reached, and the Town Clerk is required to notify and warn the Town Meeting Members then and there to meet and act on the following articles:

ARTICLE 1. To see if the Town will vote to establish under Massachusetts General law Chapter 40 section 5B a "Mosier School Stabilization Fund" for the purpose of improving, repairing or replacing the Mosier School presently located at 101 Mosier Street and furthermore, transfer from Unreserved Free Cash the sum of \$200,000 to the Mosier School Stabilization Fund, or take any other action thereto.

ARTICLE 2. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate and/or transfer from other available funds the sum of \$75,000 to the Compensation, or take any other action thereto.

ARTICLE 3. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate and/or transfer from other available funds to the Other Post Employment Benefit Fund (OPEB) \$200,000, or take any other action thereto.

ARTICLE 4. To see if the Town will vote to allow the Selectboard to enter into an agreement with Friends of South Hadley Dog Park a registered 501c3 to allow said group to operate an area for socializing and exercising dogs at Mulligan Drive (see addendum A) within regulations set forth by Friends of the South Hadley Dog Park, accepted by the Selectboard and open to the public with no required fee or take other action relative thereto.

ARTICLE 5. To see if the Town will transfer from Unreserved Free Cash or other available funds the sum of \$30,000 for the purpose of, providing up to a \$25,000 match for a Stanton Grant for the dog park, and the remaining \$5,000 to provide for a potable water connection to the park and/or related startup costs for the dog park, or take any other action relative thereto.

ARTICLE 6. To see if the Town will vote to transfer from Unreserved Free Cash the sum of \$200,000 to the Senior Center Stabilization Fund, or take any other action thereto.

ARTICLE 7. To see if the Town will vote to transfer from Unreserved Free Cash the sum of \$200,000 to the Capital Stabilization Fund and \$100,000 to the Stabilization Fund, or take any other action thereto.

ARTICLE 8. To see if the Town will transfer from Unreserved Free Cash the sum of \$30,000 to the (1920) Public Building Maintenance (11922 52410) Repair/Maintenance of Buildings to refund the account for costs associated with replacement of the main sewer pipe from Town Hall and installation of a new walk way, or take any other action thereto.


ARTICLE 9. To see if the Town will transfer from Sealers of Weights and Measures (12441-51360) the sum of \$6,215 to Other Expense, Inter-Municipal Agreement, or take any other action thereto.


ARTICLE 10. To see if the Town will transfer from Ledges Golf Course (6800) Personal Expense the sum of \$500, and from Valley View (6810) Personal Expense and Other Expense the sum \$500 and from Ledges FY 19 Retained Earnings the sum of \$89,000 and from Unreserved Free Cash the sum of \$ 100,000 and Raise and Appropriate \$522,692 to Ledges (686682 52260) Annual Contracts, or take any other action thereto.


ARTICLE 11. To see if the Town will vote to transfer from Unreserved Free Cash the sum of \$35,000 to fund an Americans with Disability Act (ADA) Self-evaluation and Transition Plan, or take any other action thereto.

ARTICLE 12. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate or transfer from WWTP Retained earnings the sum of \$145,000 to fund a grant match of an equal amount National Fish and Wildlife Futures Grant, or take any other action thereto.



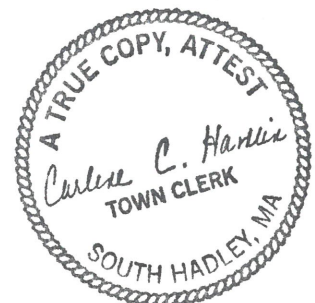
