




Titus Pond is impounded by Queensville Dam under Route 116/Newton Street. Buttery Brook is culverted under this road, where it daylights and then crosses under Mountain Ave and Joffre Ave. From there, a combination of daylight and culverted sections lead it to South Hadley Falls – see below.
